

Downtown

Medpace Denver is in the heart of Denver's historic downtown district, known as "LoDo." LoDo blends commercial and residential spaces and offers many attractions. Stroll the 16th Street Mall, only one block from Medpace. From there, explore the dozens of restaurants and shops in and around Union Station. While in LoDo, be sure to check out the 19th century architecture of Larimer Square, Denver's oldest city block, which still boasts thriving businesses and stately homes. And don't miss the Denver Convention Center, with its famous 40-foot-tall sculpture called the "Big Blue Bear."

Cherry Creek

Cherry Creek is a few miles southeast of downtown. This affluent neighborhood boasts an upscale indoor shopping mall, high-end boutiques, and art galleries, plus a blend of eclectic restaurants, cafés, and cocktail lounges.

Washington Park

Washington Park is a residential district in south-central Denver. Its layout is based on George Washington's gardens at Mount Vernon. Its most popular features include two lakes, flower gardens, bike/running paths, and tennis courts.

The historic Highland neighborhood lies just east of the South Platte River and north of downtown. Known for its hip restaurants, bars, and shops.

Littleton is 8 miles south of Denver. It is one of the most popular suburbs in the metro area with both locals and tourists. The historic downtown is lined with antique stores, cozy restaurants, bars, and specialty shops.

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS

Art District on Santa Fe

This is a unique cultural and creative district with more than 50 art galleries, restaurants, and shops. On the first Friday of every month, visitors can enjoy an event known as the "First Friday Art Walk."

Denver Art Museum

The Denver Art Museum is housed within the iconic Frederic C. Hamilton Building, which stands among the historic and cultural structures of the Denver Civic Center. The museum was designed by renowned architect Daniel Libeskind and features more than 70,000 diverse collections.

Botanic Garden

Located in the Cheesman Park neighborhood, this 23-acre park includes a conservatory, seven gardens, and an amphitheater. It features North America's largest collection of plants, which are gathered from cold weather regions around the world.

The museum houses more than one million artifacts. It is a resource for science education and provides an overview on the natural history of Colorado.

Molly Brown House Museum

This beautiful Victorian house was the home of American philanthropist and socialite Margaret Brown, known as Molly Brown, who was a passenger on the Titanic and survived to share her story.

Assembly and the offices of the Governor of Colorado and Lieutenant Governor of Colorado. The elevation of Denver is displayed outside the west entrance to the building ("One Mile Above Sea Level" or 5,280 feet).

Elitch Gardens Theme Park

This is Denver's largest amusement park, located downtown. Elitch Gardens features an assortment of rides, from roller coasters to drop towers to water rides.

DENVER ART MUSEUM

HIKES NEAR DENVER

Colorado is world-renowned for its hiking. There are thousands of trails to satisfy everyone, from beginner to advanced hiker. And the landscapes are diverse, ranging from lush forests to red rock deserts, deep canyons to snow-covered peaks, and more.

Red Rocks Mountain Park (Trading Post Trail)

Drive less than 20 minutes from Denver and you will arrive at the Trading Post Trail. This is an easy, family-friendly hike of 2.8 miles round trip. The trail is nestled within Red Rocks Mountain Park, where the famous concert venue Red Rocks Amphitheater lies. Following a hike, visitors often like to stop by the cozy neighboring town of Morrison for lunch.

Chautaugua

Located in Boulder, 29 miles northwest of Denver. Chautaugua offers 40 miles of hiking trails ranging from easy to difficult.

Garden of the Gods

Located 70 miles south of Denver in Colorado Springs, Garden of the Gods is known for its towering red sandstone formations and panoramic views of Pikes Peak. The area includes 31 great hiking trails, biking paths, running trails, and more! The trails range from easy to moderate.

Emerald Lake

One of the most heavily trafficked trails in Colorado, Emerald Lake is a 3.5-mile loop in Rocky Mountain National Park (RMNP). The trailhead is near Estes Park (64 miles northwest of Denver), with difficulty levels varying from easy to moderate.

Note: Make an online reservation before trying to visit Emerald Lake and/ or RMNP. Reservations can fill up days or weeks in advance, so make yours as soon as possible if you plan to visit.

St. Mary's Glacier

St. Mary's Glacier lies just outside the small town of Idaho Springs, less than 50 minutes by car from Denver. This destination makes a perfect day trip. The trail is a 1.5-mile loop ranging from easy to moderate in difficulty. Once you reach the summit, you will have a panoramic view of majestic St. Mary's Lake, which makes the hike even more worthwhile.

Located in Littleton, just a 20-minute drive from Denver, Deer Creek Canyon Park has several trails that you can tailor to an individualized workout.

Washington Park

Washington Park is a replica of George Washington's gardens at Mount Vernon. Its 155 acres lie in the heart of an affluent residential area and encompass two lakes, flower gardens, bike/running paths, tennis courts, and more. Locals enjoy playing volleyball, jogging, and paddle boating on the lake.

PARKS

Confluence Park

This is an urban park where Cherry Creek and the South Platte River meet. The park is near the Aquarium, the Children's Museum of Denver at Marsico Campus, and the Elitch Gardens amusement park. Locals use Confluence Park for fishing, kayaking, picnicking, and sun-bathing during warmer months.

Sloan's Lake Park

Sloan's Lake is the largest lake in Denver and very popular with water sports enthusiasts. Visitors can enjoy stunning views of the Rocky Mountains and the Denver skyline. The Sloan's Lake neighborhood that surrounds the park is one of the most popular residential districts in Denver.

ATTRACTIONS NEAR DENVER

Central City & Black Hawk

These former gold rush towns are home to several casinos that are open 24 hours/7 days per week. Black Hawk is 20 miles west of Golden. Next to Black Hawk is Central City, located in the mountains of Gilpin County.

Georgetown

Located 45 minutes from Denver, this former silver mining town is home to restored 19th century buildings and is a charming place for a day trip. Restaurants and antique stores are found on historic Main Steet. Georgetown Loop Railroad is a famous (and historic) narrow gauge railroad that transports passengers through sections of the magnificent Rocky Mountains.

Glenwood Springs

Located 160 miles west of Denver, Glenwood Springs is known for its geothermal hot springs. Glenwood Hot Springs Resort offers the world's largest hot springs pool, and world-class spa treatments are also available. Hot springs are just one of the many things to do in Glenwood Springs. During the summer months, visitors enjoy white water rafting, kayaking, fishing, mountain biking, hiking, climbing, golfing, and more!

Royal Gorge

One of the most popular tourist attractions in Colorado, and located near Canon City, the Royal Gorge is approximately 130 miles southwest of Denver. The Royal Gorge Bridge stretches 1,053 feet above the Arkansas River and is America's highest suspension bridge. The bridge connects both sides of the 1,200-foot canyon.

Located 70 miles south of Denver, Colorado Springs offers many fun destinations for visitors, including the Garden of the Gods, the Broadmoor Seven Falls, Manitou Springs, Pikes Peak, the U.S. Air Force Academy, the Cheyenne Mountain Zoo, and more.

Estes Park

Estes Park is a hub for outdoor sports enthusiasts, located about 70 miles northwest of Denver at the base of Rocky Mountain National Park. Visitors enjoy year-round wilderness recreation. Winter brings cold-weather activities like snowshoeing, sledding, and skiing. During the warmer months, visitors enjoy camping, backpacking, day hiking, horseback riding, fishing, and wildlife viewing. The town also features the historic Stanley Hotel, which inspired Stephen King's 1977 bestselling novel, *The Shining*.


Pikes Peak

Pikes Peak is one of Colorado's "Fourteeners" (summits 14,000+ feet above sea level). The mountain rises from the middle of Pike National Forest, 12 miles west of Colorado Springs. The summit is renowned for its breathtaking scenery. Peak Highway, which supplies year-round motorized access to Pikes Peak, requires reservations. You may also be able to take a scenic railway up to the top of the mountain.

Denver Nuggets

The Nuggets are an NBA franchise that play in the Northwest Division and have been a frequent playoff team. The Nuggets are an original ABA franchise, before the ABA merged with the NBA in the 1970s. As of 2022, reigning twotime NBA MVP Nikola Jokic starts at center for the Nuggets. The team plays its home games at Ball Arena.

The Avalanche were 2022 Stanley Cup champions. The current lineup features NHL stars Nathan MacKinnon and Cale Makar. The Avalanche also play their home games at Ball Arena.

Denver Broncos

Perhaps the most popular professional sports team in Denver, the Broncos are an original AFL team, before the AFL merged with the NFL in the 1960s. The Broncos are three-time Super Bowl champions with such famous past players as John Elway, Shannon Sharpe, Von Miller, and Peyton Manning. The Broncos compete in the AFC West division. In 2022, they have a new quarterback, Russell Wilson, who is a past Super Bowl winner. The Broncos play their home games at Empower Field in downtown Denver.

Colorado Rockies

The Rockies contend in the National League West division and play their home games at Coors Field, in the Lower Downtown Area. Although the Rockies have never won a championship, fans still flock to games for a renowned stadium experience. The "party deck" at Coors Field is somewhat unique in baseball and usually jammed with fans.

The Rapids are a professional soccer team that competes in the MLS Western Conference. The Rapids play their home games at Dick's Sporting Goods Park in Commerce City (north Denver), which is a modern, cozy venue to watch a game.

National Western Stock Show

This is an annual livestock show, rodeo, horse show, and festival held every January at the National Western Complex in Denver since 1906. This family-friendly festival offers multiple immersive programs, exhibits, and events.


