





Madisonville

Medpace is located in Madisonville, a community north of downtown Cincinnati. Madisonville is quickly growing while focusing on six priorities: economic development, health and wellness, the environment, community engagement, arts and culture, and education and youth.

Downtown

Downtown Cincinnati is rich with history, displayed in neighborhoods with unique character and wide offerings. In the West End is the Cincinnati Museum Center and to the east is Mt. Adams. To the north is Over-the-Rhine and the Cincinnati Zoo. The riverfront is bustling in Smale Park and dining on The Banks.

OTR was built in the 19th century by German immigrants. An urban renewal program has revitalized the area, and over the last few years OTR has become a foodie mecca! It's also home to Cincinnati Music Hall, Washington Park, and Findlay Market.

In addition to shopping and dining, Mt. Adams is home to Eden Park, where you can find Cincinnati Playhouse in the Park and Krohn Conservatory. Works spanning 6,000 years are on display at the Cincinnati Art Museum.

Hyde Park is a neighborhood in the center of Cincinnati. The neighborhood was originally created to be an exclusive community for Cincinnati's wealthy elite. Hyde Park offers a variety of restaurants and unique boutiques. Pedestrian-friendly.

Oakley

Oakley was originally known as "Four Mile," because it was a popular stop in the mid-1800s for wagons on the Madison Turnpike, now Madison Road. It was named Oakley because of the many oak trees. Oakley has two shopping centers: Hyde Park Plaza and Oakley Square.

Norwood

This Cincinnati suburb has a population of 20,000 people. It's a growing neighborhood for young professionals, attracted by the expanding number of restaurants, bars, and shops. Rookwood Commons & Pavilion is a popular destination for dining and entertainment.

Located in the southeastern corner of Hamilton County, Ohio, it's one of the most heavily populated townships in the state with about 45,000 people. Anderson Township is bounded by the Little Miami and Ohio Rivers.

Montgomery is located northeast of Cincinnati, Ohio. It was founded in 1795 and was known as a stopping point along the old "3-C" Highway (Cincinnati-Columbus-Cleveland). Montgomery is now easily accessible at the crossroads of I-275, I-71, Ronald Reagan Cross County Highway and US 22/Ohio 3 (locally known as Montgomery Road, the "main street" through town).
